The Cool Chords

Four guitar chord diagrams are shown:

- Bm(b6)**: Fretboard diagram with fingerings x 1 3 0 2 x.
- Gmaj7**: Fretboard diagram with fingerings 1 x 3 0 2 x.
- A7sus4(13)**: Fretboard diagram with fingerings x 0 3 0 2 x.
- Dadd4**: Fretboard diagram with a 5th fret barre and fingerings x 4 3 0 2 x.

Cool Chords in 7/8 Time Tablature

Two systems of guitar tablature are shown:

- System 1**: Shows the first three chords. The top line is marked with a 7 (7/8 time). The bottom line is marked with an 8 (8th fret). The chords are Bm(b6), Gmaj7, and A7sus4(13). Each chord has a rhythmic pattern of four eighth notes.
